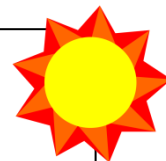
## **FROM THE PRINCIPAL**

## **FROM THE PASTOR**

Everybody enjoys a break from the regular routine, and I am sure that our students will enjoy a break from school, studies, and spend some time on Spring Break playing some games, reading a good book, or just relaxing. Spring break is a time that I always looked forward to as a child myself. Whatever your family has in store, I wish you God's blessings on your Spring break time together.

When we come back from Spring break, it will be "Holy Week." Holy Week is the most important week in the church year. In fact, as a believer in our Lord, I would say that Holy Week is the most important week in the history of the world. For you see, Holy Week remembers the last days of Jesus on earth as He moved toward laying His life down on the cross for the salvation of everyone, but especially of those who believe (1 Timothy 4:9-10).

Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday, when Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey in fulfillment of Old Testament prophecy (Zechariah 9:9). Jesus cleared the temple of those buying and selling, for His Father's house was to be a house of prayer but corrupt leaders had turned it into a den of robbers (Jeremiah 7:9-11; Matthew 21:12-13). Jesus instituted His holy supper we call the Lord's Supper (Matthew 26) and was finally handed over to Pontius Pilate who gave into the will of the mob and sentenced Jesus to death by crucifixion (Matthew 27). All of that took place in a period of six days. It is indeed the most holy of weeks.

I would like to encourage your family to come and worship on these most holy days. We have Palm Sunday services at 5pm March 24 and 8 & 10:30am March 25. We remember the institution of the Lord's Supper on Thursday, March 29, at 10am and 6pm. We remember the sufferings of Christ on the cross on Good Friday, March 30, at 1pm and 6pm. We have the Easter Vigil on Saturday, March 31, at 5pm. Then, on Easter, our services are 7am, 9am, and 11am. Come and be blessed by remember the events of that Holy Week in which our Lord accomplished our salvation.
