FROM THE PRINCIPAL

- Easter Break is Friday, **March 30th** through Monday, **April 2nd**. We do not have school these two days. Have a Blessed Easter!
- The next round of MPCP Open Enrollment begins **April 1st** and ends **April 20th**.
- WPCP is open until **April 20th**. No WPCP applications will be considered if they are not verified and submitted by 4:00pm on Friday, **April 20th**.
- For Tuition-paying families, the ½ price re-enrollment (registration) fee ends on Wednesday, **April 18th**. Now the cost is \$75 per students, after **April 18th** it is \$150 per student. So if you did not turn in your Contract for Enrollment and your re-enrollment fee, please do so as soon as possible to avoid the higher fee.
- Achievement Test Week is coming soon. All students in grades K - 8 will be taking achievement tests the week of **April 23rd**. Please check with your child's teacher if you have any questions.
- **Great News** - we have two new people joining our faculty next year. One will be our new 7th grade teacher (next year 7th and 8th grade will have their own homerooms instead of being combined like they are this year), and one will be our new Early Childhood Administrator. I will share more with you in the weeks to come, but watch for information coming out soon regarding enrollment opportunities at the ECC.

As this goes out, we find ourselves just four days away from Easter. Whew! The year is going by fast! It seems like just yesterday it was Christmas. Now the Festival of our Lord's Resurrection has arrived. Christmas proclaims the Son of God who became man to save us from our sins. Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, and Good Friday point us to His life, suffering, and death for all people. The "Hosannas!" of Palm Sunday gave way to shouts of "Crucify Him!" on Good Friday.

If Christmas proclaims the Son of God become man, Easter proclaims the victory of our Lord and Savior over death itself. If there is no Easter, there is nothing to celebrate at Christmas. As the Apostle Paul put it...
