SCRIP

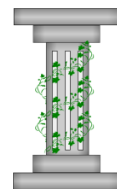

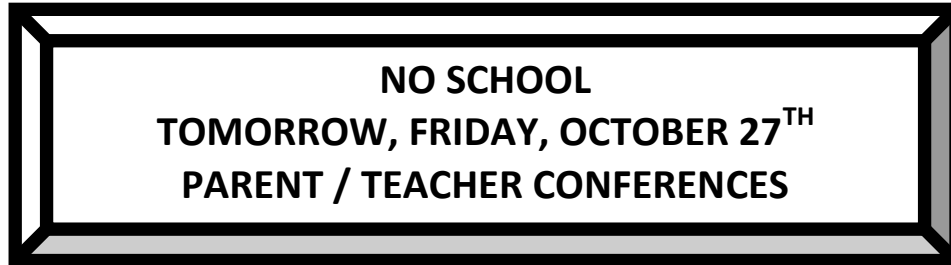
MALICE IN THE PALACE: THE STORY OF ESTHER MUSICAL
