On October 31, 1517, a man named Martin Luther nailed 95 theses (theological statements) on the church doors in Wittenberg, Germany. This began what we now call the Reformation. Many people know little or nothing about what took place because of the Reformation, yet all of our lives have been affected. The most important thing that took place in the church is that the Gospel of Jesus Christ as Savior was brought again to forefront. This month marks the 500th anniversary of that event. ***You are all invited to a movie night***, here at St. Paul's.
