FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Security Updates

The safety of all students, staff, and visitors is something we take very seriously. We are constantly evaluating our building security and updating policies and procedures. As a result of that we are implementing the following changes:

- **Visitor Registration**-anyone that visits our campuses MUST come to the Office first and sign in. They will then be issued a bright yellow Visitor badge to be worn at all times while in the building. This holds true for every visit, from dropping off a lunch in someone's locker to visiting a classroom. Students will be taught to look for the bright yellow Visitor stickers and to report anyone not registered to their teacher.
- **Classroom and Office doors** will now be closed and locked during the day.
- Please know that there have been no incidents or problems here at SPWA. We are always analyzing our Emergency Response Plans with the WAPD, making updates where needed, and then using those plans to teach our children the appropriate responses.
- The money PTL raises from the **Color-Run** this year will all go towards more security upgrades. Our goal is to raise \$10,000.



Security Costs

Listed below are some of our wish-list security items. Perhaps your place of work offers grants or has a matching gifts program that would allow you or your employer to purchase, or help purchase some of the items.

- Electronic locks on Office door (\$3000)
- Portable radios for all staff (\$3000 (15 X200))
- Shatterproof film on Office windows (\$700)
- Shatterproof film on ECC windows (\$8000)

From the Pastor

In the past couple of weeks I have begun to teach the 8th grade students about the Christian faith using God's Word, the Bible, and Luther's Small Catechism. As I began this instruction, I made this statement: "I think that too many of us Christians know things **about** God more than we know the **heart of God**." I actually include myself in that statement. For example, we can know the general truth: God created everything. Now that is truly an important truth to acknowledge and many in our world reject that. However, we get more of the **heart of God** when we grow to know the truth of Psalm 139: **God knit me together in my mother's womb and I am fearfully and wonderfully made!!** The heart of our God was involved in personally creating you and me. What a wonderful truth that I should ponder more often. Of course there are all kinds of things to learn of God's heart, like how much our God hates sin (the things we do wrong) but how much more He loves and forgives us in Jesus and empowers us to live as His people.

Tonight I am beginning to teach an "Adult Instruction Class" which is called "To Know the Truth." It begins at 6:30 in our church and school library. While we have had sign-ups for the past couple of weeks, if you would like to come you are welcome. It is all about getting to know God, His truth, and His heart. The double doors facing Lincoln Avenue will be unlocked at 6:15pm and locked up again about 6:35pm.

Whether or not you join the class, my hope for all of our students, toddlers through 8th grade and their families, is that we all grow together in knowing the heart of our God.
