Rates for Childcare**

Registration Fee

\$50.00/Family Registration Fee due at time of enrollment or upon re-registration (non-refundable).

6 weeks up to 2 years old

Full Day: \$60.00 (more than 5 hours per day)

Half Day: \$30.00 (up to 5 hours per day, minimum of two days per week)

2 years through 4 year olds

Full Day: \$50.00 (more than 5 hours per day)

Half Day: \$30.00 (up to 5 hours per day, minimum of two days per week)

Full Day Kindergarten through age 12

Full School Day \$4.00 per hour (Before and after school care)

*****Early Release/Non-school Day**

\$40.00 (more than 5 hours)

\$24.00 (up to 5 hours per day)

**Late Pick-Up Fee of \$10.00/day if child is picked up after their scheduled contracted time without notice

** You are responsible for signing your child up during ER and NS Days. Non-refundable: Your account will be charged if you sign up and do not use the program.

**Sibling Discount of 5% will be applied to the tuition fee for the oldest child of any family with multiple children enrolled in the program, provided at least two children are in attendance that week.

**NFS Fee: In addition to any bank penalties, there is a \$25.00 fee for any NFS status on a monthly withdrawal. If an NFS status is shown the monthly payment will need to be made by certified check or cash within 15 days for enrollment to continue and auto withdrawal to be re-established.

Extended Leave Holding Fee: If you anticipate a leave longer than 2 weeks authorization and **a full weeks deposit per child is required to hold the spot. Fee will be applied to care charges upon returning to SPL Child Care. Non-refundable if you decide to terminate your enrollment.

**Referral Bonus: \$50.00 credit per family for referring families that enroll and attend at least 30 days.

**Complimentary Days are based on contracted number of days your child will attend weekly: You will be charged for all days' child is in attendance. These days can be used for sickness or personal days; generally a deviation from the normal schedule. These days are for the year and cannot be carried over.

Full Time (5 days per week will receive 7 complimentary days per year)

Full Time (4 days per week will receive 5 complimentary days per year)

Part Time (2-3 days per week will receive 3 complimentary days per year)
