LINCOLN CAR LINE

Since receiving my promotion to Crossing Guard, I have had a front row seat to what has come to be known affectionately as “Car Line”. While that experience has greatly improved and we have become much more efficient, I think there is still room for improvement.

1. **No Left Turn**-Trying to turn left on Lincoln is a challenging maneuver. While it is legal, it is dangerous and really backs up the flow of cars. If you need to go West, try turning right on Lincoln, then right on 78th Street, then right on either Hayes or Arthur Avenues.
2. **Crossing Lincoln to ECC**- as an alternative to trying to cross Lincoln Avenue (another hair-raising maneuver), try turning right on Lincoln and then left on 78th to Grant Street.
3. **Pull Up to the front sign or cone.** Enough said on that.
