A few notes:

- Our fundraising goal for this school year is **\$10,000**. This will allow us to continue making security upgrades, especially the installation of the security film on the ECC windows and entrances.
- All the security film is in place at the Lincoln building. Over the summer a security film was added to the outside doors and 1st floor windows of the Lincoln building. This film makes the glass harder to breach and it also holds the glass together if it is shattered. With this new film we will also need to be careful with what we put on the windows as we cannot use a razor blade on the film. Please do not put anything up on the windows or doors without contacting Mr. Haas or Mr. Burkee first.
- I will be working with the WAPD on other ways to improve our facilities and make them even more secure.

In Christ, the community of St. Paul's Lutheran School partners with families to equip children academically and prepare children and families spiritually to witness and serve.

- Our largest fund-raiser of the Fall is going to be our first ever **Color Run**, held October 13 at Martin Luther High School! This takes the place of selling butter-braids as we have done the last couple years. LOTS more information about this super-fun event will come home with your child tomorrow (Friday).
- Car-line has been going pretty well. Please remember that you may not park or wait on the west side of 79th street before the alley. All cars should be heading north bound on 79th and pulling into the “Cone Zone”.
- Next Thursday, September 5th is our first spirit day of the year. In recognition of the NFL season getting underway and the Packers playing the Bears that night, all students are invited to wear their Packer gear or Packer colors to school that day.
