## FROM THE PASTOR

To the community of St. Paul's

I pray that you are well and that your family continues to remain healthy in this pandemic and that you are holding onto Jesus in the midst of all joys and challenges.

The month of February is often associated with the theme of *love* because of Valentine's Day, which remembers the charity shown by St. Valentine in the third century A.D. Love, it seems, has been in short supply among people in society in recent months due to a variety of issues and disagreements. I want to encourage all of you (including myself) to be people of *love*. Love will push us through challenges and disagreements. Love will position yourself in humility, rather than superiority. Love covers a multitude of sins. Love requires first that we check ourselves at the door before we enter a conversation or situation that could be hostile. At St. Paul's Lutheran Church & School, we are called by God to be people of *love*. Paul writes it this way in the great love chapter of the bible:

*"If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. If I give away all I have and if I deliver up my body to be burned, but have not love, I gain nothing."*
