You know, sometimes we get so caught up in doing so many different things in life we can lose sight of what is really important in life. We can also be so earthly minded and we forget the God of heaven and earth and the hope He gives us for an abundant life now and even an eternal life to come.

One of the things that I love about God's holy Word is that it is all about life . . . real life, and life with all its ups and downs. I hope that you caught the musical this week. It presented the story of very real people who lived in Bethany, near Jerusalem, in the days that Jesus walked the earth. It is a story of three siblings, Mary, Martha, and their brother, Lazarus.

On that day when they invited Jesus over for dinner, Mary and Martha got into a little squabble; they had some words. But, like I said earlier, we can get so caught up in doing so many things we lose sight of what's really important. This is what happened to Martha. She was so concerned about putting on a good meal and setting a fine table that she forgot

who was sitting in her house: Jesus, God's Son, her Savior and Lord. Mary knew this and just sat at Jesus feet, listening to Him. We should too. (If you missed the musical, you can read about it in Luke 10:38-42.
